The Marysville Kiwanis Club established this scholarship with a donation from Sargent V Chamberlain, for his interest in education and youth, and dedication to Kiwanis of which he was a past president and served on numerous committees for the benefit of the organization. This was presented to Marysville Kiwanis to recognize his children, grandchildren, nephews and nieces who have graduated from Fairbanks High School.

The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage qualified students of the Fairbanks High School to seek education beyond high school and to provide financial assistance. The scholarship will be awarded annually in the amount of \$1,000.00. The scholarship will be non-renewable, that is, a different student will receive the award each year.

The scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior at the Fairbanks High School who is planning to attend a four-year baccalaureate degree program. Qualities of character, industriousness, integrity, need, class ranking and perseverance will be considerations taken by the scholarship committee. Also taken under consideration by the committee, is if any of your relatives are members of Kiwanis or if you are a Key Club member.

Requirements for each applicant:

1. The application must be completed in full. The committee will not consider an application not completed in full. The completed application must be mailed prior to April 15, 2012 to: Marysville Kiwanis Club, Sargent V Chamberlain-Kiwanis College Scholarship, P O Box 340, Marysville, Ohio, 43040.
2. The applicant must be a graduating senior at Fairbanks High School at the time of application.
3. The applicant must state the school to which an application for admission is to be made. Although scholarships may be awarded before notice of admission, they are conditioned upon the enrollment of the applicant in an undergraduate course in a recognized college or university. The committee reserves the right to determine whether the school selected qualifies under this definition. The scholarship check will be made payable both to the school and the applicant.
4. Two personal recommendations must be submitted in addition to the application, but not accompanying it. Forms for the recommendations will be provided with the application and should be mailed separately by the recommending person to the above address of the committee. One recommendation must be made by a teacher. And one recommendation by a former employer or a responsible adult in the community in which the applicant lives.
5. The principal or guidance counselor must provide a transcript and complete the required form for the applicant, which they are to mail to the above address.
